## State Fireworks Requirements

- Public Display License Required (Yes or No) If Yes, is there a fee? May be required by local authorities, fee may be required.
- Commercial General Liability Insurance Coverage (Min per occurrence) May be required. Amount set by local authorities.
- HazMat Transportation Insurance – DOT Compliant
- State Transportation Permit Required (Yes or No)
- Worker Compensation Insurance – Statutory or Other No
- Import/Export License to bring products into the state (Yes or No) If Yes, is there a fee? \$250.00 annually
- Wholesale License to purchase or sell products in the state (Yes or No) If Yes, is there a fee? \$250.00 annually
- Registration of individuals authorized to represent License holder in the state (Yes or No)
- Permit from Local AHJ for each display (Maybe) – Fee and permit application dependent upon location.
- Permit Filing Period for Local: How many days prior? Each local is different
- Permit Filing Period for State: How many days? N/A
- State Bond Required (Yes or No)

## State Pyrotechnic Operator Requirements

- Minimum Age: 21
- Minimum of Documented displays: 3
- Minimum Experience: Must have training from a state approved training course
- Letters of Recommendation (Yes or No) If Yes, How many and from whom
- Written Test Required (Yes or No) If Yes, how often? Must retake written every 5 years
- Minimum Passing Score: 70%
- New Operator License Fee (\$ Amount) \$40.00 each license
- Renewal Operator License Fee (\$ Amount) \$40.00 each license, Annually
- Renewal Period for Licensed Operator Annually

**OTHER:**

There are four state licenses. Each license is independent of each other and each is \$40.00 annually.

- a) Display Operator;
- b) (b) Special Effects Operator;
- c) (c) Flame Effects Operator; or
- d) (d) Flame Effects Performing Artist.

Must renew prior to every year, in the fifth year you must take a written test that is mailed to you.
