Consumer Fireworks

Specifically Permitted	All items that comply with the requirements of the CPSC, except stick-type rockets having a tube less than ¼" inside diameter. Municipalities may prohibit use of aerial and ground audible devices.
Specifically Prohibited	
Selling Period	Permissible fireworks may be sold at retail: Between June 20 and July 6 Six days preceding and including New Year's Day Three days preceding and including Chinese New Year September 16 and May 5 Cinco de Mayo Except permissible fireworks may be sold all year in permanent retail stores whose primary business is tourism.
Age of Purchase	16 years of age and older.
Licensing	Manufacturer license \$1,500 Distributor license 2,000 Wholesaler license 1,000 Display distributor license 1,000 Specialty retailer license 750; Retailer permit 100; or replacement permit 20.
