State Fireworks Requirements

- Public Display Permit Required: Varies by Community
- Commercial General Liability Insurance Coverage - Varies \$1 to \$10 Million per occurrence
- HazMat Transportation Insurance: MCS – 90 per USDOT
- State Transportation Permit Required: No
- Worker Compensation Insurance: Statutory
- Import/Export License to bring products into the state: No
- Wholesale/Retail License to purchase or sell products in the state: Fed ATF and Local Approval
- Registration of individuals authorized to represent License holder in the state: No
- Permit from Local AHJ for each display: Varies by location
- Permit Filing Period for Local: How many days prior: Varies by location
- Permit Filing Period for State: N/A
- State Bond Required: Yes, Depending on the location

- Minimum Age: 18 (Statutory Federal Law regarding Hazmat)
