Specifically Fountains, ground spinners, illuminating torches; dipped sticks and sparklers; toy propellants; trick noise makers; and tube devices.

sparklers; toy propellants; trick noise makers; and tube devices. Permissible fireworks may not contain more than 50 milligrams of

explosive composition.

Specifically Prohibited

Firecrackers, rockets (including bottle rockets), roman candles, cherry

bombs, mortars and similar items, such as M-80s.

Selling Period Primarily June 15 to July 4, subject to each local jurisdiction.

Age of purchase 16 years of age or older.
