## State Fireworks Requirements

- Public Display License Required: Yes, \$50 per display
- Commercial General Liability Insurance Coverage: Min \$25,000 injury of one person; \$50,000 injury of more than one person; \$10,000 in property damage HazMat Transportation Insurance – DOT Compliant (1.4 – \$1M / 1.3 \$5M)
- State Transportation Permit Required (Yes or No) No (permit required to store fireworks)
- Worker Compensation Insurance – Other- Yes
- Import/Export License to bring products into the state (Yes or No) If Yes, is there a fee? No
- Wholesale License to purchase or sell products in the state (Yes or No) If Yes, is there a fee? Yes, \$750.00
- Registration of individuals authorized to represent License holder in the state (Yes or No) Yes
- Permit from Local AHJ for each display (Yes or No) – Fee dependent upon location.
- Permit Filing Period for Local: How many days prior?
- Permit Filing Period for State: 10 days (\$50 late fee)
- State Bond Required: Yes

## State Pyrotechnic Operator Requirements

- Minimum Age: 21 years
- Minimum of Documented displays: N/A
- Minimum Experience: Asked on application
- Letters of Recommendation: No
- Written Test Required: Yes, every three years
- Minimum Passing Score: N/A
- New Operator License Fee: \$150
- Renewal Operator License Fee (\$ Amount) \$150.00
- Renewal Period for Licensed Operator: 3 years
