CONSUMER FIREWORKS

Specifically permitted May 20 –July 6
Dec. 10 – Jan. 3

Ground based sparkling devices including fountains multiple tube cake devices, illuminating torches, wheels, and ground spinners

Specifically permitted year round

Sparklers, smoker devices, and novelty devices as defined in APA Std. 87-1 2001 edition.

Specifically prohibited

Aerial consumer fireworks, bottle & sky rockets, helicopters, torpedoes, roman candles & jumping jacks.

AERIAL CONSUMER, DISPLAY FIREWORKS & PYROTECHNICS

Consumer Fireworks Permits

Check local regulations for permit fees, zoning, and fire inspections.

Display Permits

Fire Marshal has permit authority over all fireworks and pyrotechnics displays & events on public school, state, and country properties.

Insurance

May be required by local authorities

Operator

No license specifically required by state law but may be required by local authorities.
